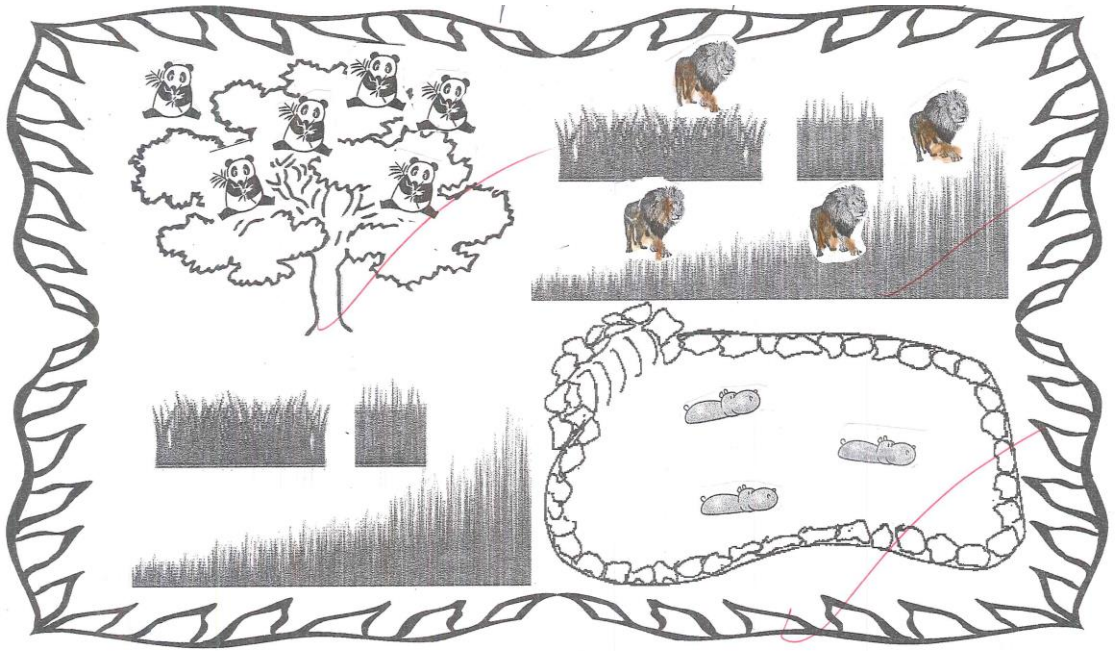




My Zoo

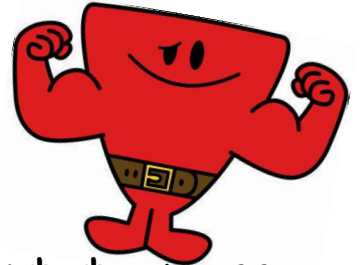

It was really frightening and it would be Anita and Mary's most exciting and unforgettable experience.



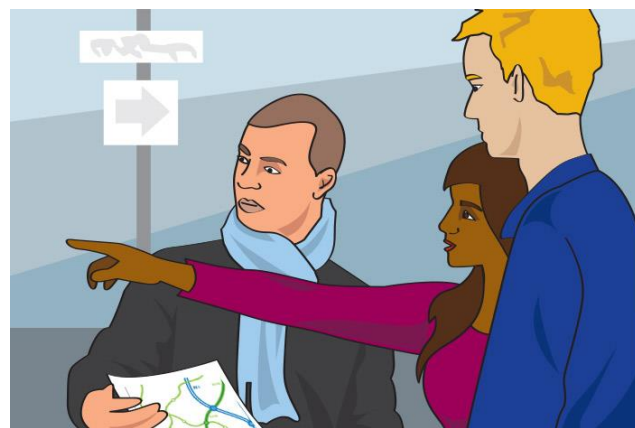
Lost on Lantau
